With the teeth of the summer heat bearing down us, non-profit Christian based organization Hope Through Education (H.T.E.) made a cool move in the 98 deg. weather today. The HTE board approved a vote to successfully provide 3 new window screens for one of Project Touch Ministries care facility homes in Murrieta Calif. In fact it was a breeze so to speak !

Project Touch representative Terry Terrant helped coordinate the effort & Screenmobile of Temecula installer Kayce provided the labor as the job was finished in about 1 hour time for the total cost of \$ 108. The 2 bedrooms and living room windows now have 3 newly installed screens allowing the cool evening air to help residents cope with the dog days of summer. Terry said this is “far better that they had” and the home was very appreciative according to Deloris who said “things worked out good and the install guy did a good job. Now we can use the windows especially at night without fear of outdoor bugs coming in”.

This was H.T.E.’s 4th event with Project Touch. Previously H.T.E. donated polar fleece blankets needed for the cold winter months in 2010 & again in Jan. of 2014. Then in April of this year, they donated 32 Easter meals for the ministry to enjoy along with a Granola breakfast for 110 people to enjoy. Newly elected President Paul Wojtkowski stated “we have been developing a closer partnership with Project Touch lately and we hope this will continue well into the future as their work is simply outstanding in the community”.
